White Cockade (courtesy of Canada) has joined this list. None have left this year.

I have highlighted anomalies in yellow (I have not included South Africa in the list below (apart from their unusual favourites) because of the relatively few programmes generated by relatively few clubs.

**Scotland and the Rest of the UK:** Largely coincide, Irish Rover and Dreamcatcher being unusually popular there. In addition they are not enamoured of Flowers of Edinburgh or Best Set in the Hall.

**The Rest of the UK:** Unusually enjoy Bees of Maggiecknockater and Belle of Bon Accord.

**USA and Canada:** Unusually keen on Flowers of Edinburgh (Canada's No 1!) and Delvine Side, but aren't as enamoured with Scott Meikle and Mairis Wedding like the rest of us.

**Australia:** Whilst having no unusual favourites, don't enjoy JB Milne, Sailor and Reel of the 51st like the rest of us do.

**Europe:** Highlight Sands of Morar and Sugar Candie, whilst mostly ignoring Bratach Bana and Maxwell's Rant

**Canada:** Enjoy Jubilee Jig more than the rest of us, but don't get excited by Polharrow Burn, Bees of Maggiecknockater and Gentleman

**New Zealand:** Have caught on to City of Belfast quicker than the rest, but don't enjoy Polharrow Burn, Bees of Maggiecknockater and Joie de Vivre (although the latter is changing)

**South Africa:** We particularly enjoy Never at Sea (can't understand why it hasn't caught on anywhere else), JB Milne and Polharrow Burn.
